In 2000, the City of Clear Lake purchased the grounds which had previously been the site of four Clear Lake Schools for 100 years, from 1888 to 1988. In 2002, the board of directors incorporated the Central Gardens of North Iowa as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. An award winning landscape architect was hired to develop a Master Plan for the site and hundreds of dedicated volunteers planted the gardens and continue to maintain them, a great example of a community of Iowans working together.
