# GETTING DOWN & DIRTY IN Central bardens

If the heart of a volunteer can be measured by the depth of their commitment to serve others, then the hearts of a core group of individuals who volunteer at Central Gardens are among the biggest. That core group, known as the Down & Dirty crew, emerged early on to do the heavy-lifting necessary to develop and maintain an ever-changing, ever-evolving, public garden.

The origins of Down & Dirty can be traced to Roger Harringa, a self-proclaimed garden grunt, who drafted the bulk of the crew that exists today. He was still in business as a contractor when he got involved with the Gardens 22 years ago. Harringa had the equipment Central Gardens needed to do the original plantings and he had a passion for landscaping and so he, along with former board member, Barb Nicholas, began to get the work organized.

They launched Down & Dirty, designating one evening a week as a time when many people could come together to accomplish bigger projects. These projects can be as hard as hard work can be. "A good physical workout," as Connie Plagge puts it, "as minimal or strenuous" as you wish. The Down & Dirty crew tackle some of the toughest jobs in Central Gardens: clearing brush, pulling stumps, digging decades old mulch, planting trees, repairing pipes and fountains, and so much more.

Jody and Connie Plagge were first introduced to Central Gardens in 2011 when their son married here. A second son married in the Gardens in 2013, the year Jody and Connie moved to Clear Lake. Harringa introduced them to others who worked in the Gardens and the Plagge's have been devoted volunteers ever since. "It was a good way to meet people," said Connie, who has experienced deep personal gratification not only from seeing the results of her work, but also in knowing that Central Gardens is enjoyed by thousands of people every year.

Harringa asked Roger Walston to help him with some projects in the Gardens while fishing together just over 10 years ago. Walston continued to help out, pitching in whenever Harringa asked him too. He has continued to work the bigger projects in the Gardens while his wife, Lee, tends to the Arrival Garden, one of over 20 themed gardens on the grounds.

Jim Butler says it is the friends he's made that keep him coming back, the camaraderie among the crew. Mark and Becke Dorenbush enjoy going to Down & Dirty as a couple, working together with others, and seeing the results of their collective efforts in the beauty of the Gardens.

When the work is done, they socialize. Walston, a home winemaker, started bringing a couple of bottles of wine with him to share. Others bring snacks, and the group uses the last 30 minutes or so of each work session to rest and get to know each other. Walston said, "The social time after the work allowed us to get to know some great people that we now consider some of our best friends."

Today, the evening Down & Dirty crew is comprised of about fifteen people: Dave Hoistad, Jim Butler, David and Jeannie Burgart, Merle and Julie Tiedemann, Jody and Connie Plagge, Mark and Becke Dorenbush, Roger and Lee Walston, Doug and Laura Marty, and Roy Markwardt. The splendor and the beauty of Central Gardens would not be possible without this fine crew. Thank you!
